Trip to the British Isles, By Bob Tamulinas: Our recent trip to Scotland, Ireland, England and Wales proved to be not only fun, but somewhat adventurous. We started off without a hitch, but Mother Nature decided to whip up a storm somewhere in the ocean. This resulted in ten foot seas one day. This would amount to nothing in an ocean liner. However in our much smaller vessel, we were rockin' 'n' rollin' for a time. The captain adjusted our itinerary by using alternate ports "for our comfort and safety" as he put it, when the weather report called for twenty foot seas in the next 24 hours. We still hit most of the scheduled attractions or visited some new ones while the seas subsided.

For me, one of the highlights was a visit to the Normandy Invasion Museum in Plymouth, England. ## Catskill Mountain Hike - North South State Park, Haines Falls, NY October 24<sup>th</sup>. 10:30 AM.

Join me on this hike through the scenic and historic Catskill Mountains. The length of the hike is about 6-7 miles with a duration of approximately 4 hours. It encompasses the 260 foot/2-tiered Kaatterskill Falls, Layman's Monument, Sunset Rock, Inspiration Pt., Boulder Rock, and the former sites of three hotels from the 1800s. The hiking path also features several scenic overlooks of Platt Cove and the Hudson Valley. Most of the trails are easy to moderate; however, there are a few moderately difficult sections. Hiking or over-the-ankle shoes are a must for these trails which vary from smooth to rocky. Hiking poles are strongly recommended. Also bring plenty of water/snacks as there are no services in the area. Dress in layers and be prepared for weather changes. Meet at the South Lake picnic area of North-South State Park at 10:30am, or if carpooling, meet at Christopher Morley parking lot at 7:00am. Admission to the park is free for residents 62 and over. We can have a well-deserved lunch at Salina's in Tannersville afterward.
